1	<b>Sir John A. Macdonald</b>	Conservative	1867–1873, 1878–1891	First PM, built CPR, Confederation
2	<b>Alexander Mackenzie</b>	Liberal	1873–1878	Introduced secret ballot
3	<b>Sir John Abbott</b>	Conservative	1891–1892	First Canadian-born PM
4	<b>Sir John Thompson</b>	Conservative	1892–1894	Criminal Code reform
5	<b>Sir Mackenzie Bowell</b>	Conservative	1894–1896	Manitoba Schools Question
6	<b>Sir Charles Tupper</b>	Conservative	1896	Shortest PM term (69 days)
7	<b>Sir Wilfrid Laurier</b>	Liberal	1896–1911	First French-Canadian PM; created Alberta & Saskatchewan
8	<b>Sir Robert Borden</b>	Conservative	1911–1920	WWI leader; Vimy Ridge; women's suffrage
9	<b>Arthur Meighen</b>	Conservative	1920–1921, 1926	King-Byng Affair
10	<b>William Lyon Mackenzie King</b>	Liberal	1921–1926, 1926–1930, 1935–1948	Longest-serving PM; WWII leader
11	<b>R. B. Bennett</b>	Conservative	1930–1935	Great Depression era; CBC, Bank of Canada
12	<b>Louis St. Laurent</b>	Liberal	1948–1957	Newfoundland joins; NATO co-founder
13	<b>John Diefenbaker</b>	PC	1957–1963	Canadian Bill of Rights; gave Indigenous vote
14	<b>Lester B. Pearson</b>	Liberal	1963–1968	Nobel Peace Prize; Canadian flag; Medicare; CPP
15	<b>Pierre Elliott Trudeau</b>	Liberal	1968–1979, 1980–1984	Charter of Rights; Constitution patriation; bilingualism
16	<b>Joe Clark</b>	PC	1979–1980	Youngest PM at 39
17	<b>John Turner</b>	Liberal	1984	Short term (79 days)
18	<b>Brian Mulroney</b>	PC	1984–1993	Free trade (NAFTA); GST; Meech Lake
19	<b>Kim Campbell</b>	PC	1993	First female PM
20	<b>Jean Chrétien</b>	Liberal	1993–2003	Balanced budgets; Clarity Act
21	<b>Paul Martin</b>	Liberal	2003–2006	Same-sex marriage; Kelowna Accord
22	<b>Stephen Harper</b>	Conservative	2006–2015	Residential schools apology; TFSA
23	<b>Justin Trudeau</b>	Liberal	2015–2025	Cannabis legalization; gender parity cabinet
